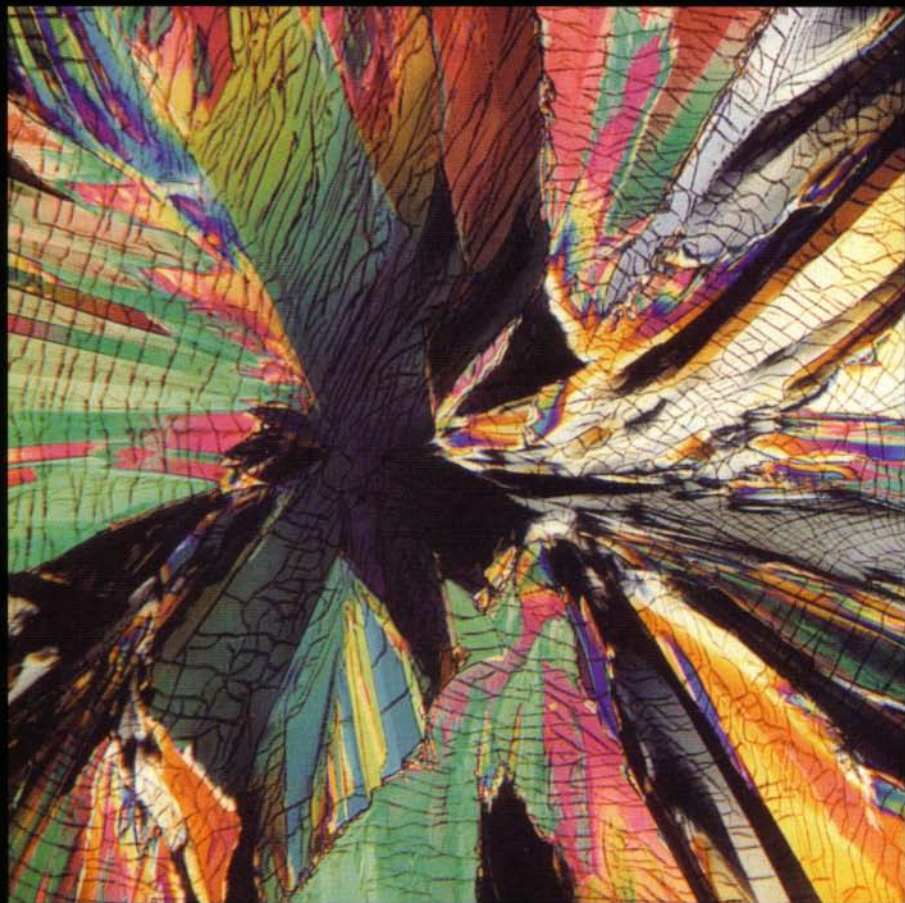

Arnold Kolb's work has been featured in exhibitions at museums, universities and cultural centers throughout the United States, including one-person shows at the Brevard Art Center and Museum, Melbourne, FL; Oregon Museum of Science and Industry, Portland; Merced College, Merced, CA; Southern Oregon State College, Ashland; Northwood University, Midland, MI; the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor and the Midland Center for the Arts, Midland, MI. In addition, his work has been featured in group exhibitions at the Detroit Institute of Arts, Detroit, MI; Museum of Science and Industry, Chicago; Impressions 5 Museum, Lansing, MI; Tubac Center of the Arts, Tubac, AZ; Pacific Science Center, Seattle, WA and the American Association for the Advancement of Science, Washington, D.C.
